It was wonderful to see a representation of so many different sports.

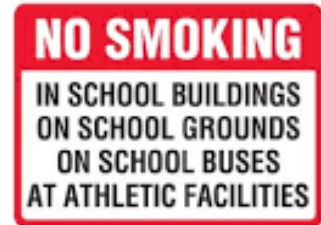
### Riverside Schools Playgroup

### Cross Country

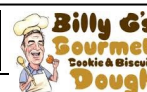
